On 06th March 2026, a Hiking-cum-Stream Cleaning Programme was held at Ganga Waterfall with the objective to promote adventure, teamwork, environmental awareness, and the spirit of service among members of Bharat Scouts & Guides and Scout & Guide Fellowship, while encouraging participants to protect nature through conservation activities such as stream cleaning. The Joint State SGF & BS&G Arunachal Hiking-cum-Stream Cleaning Drive was conducted under the guidance of Kempfi Pakam, State Training Commissioner (G).
