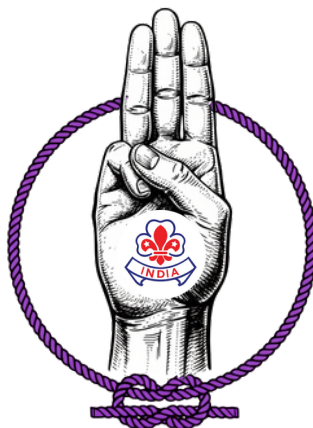

Detailed discussions and deliberations on the up-coming International Youth Day Celebrations and Youth Awards Ceremony 2026 were taken up.

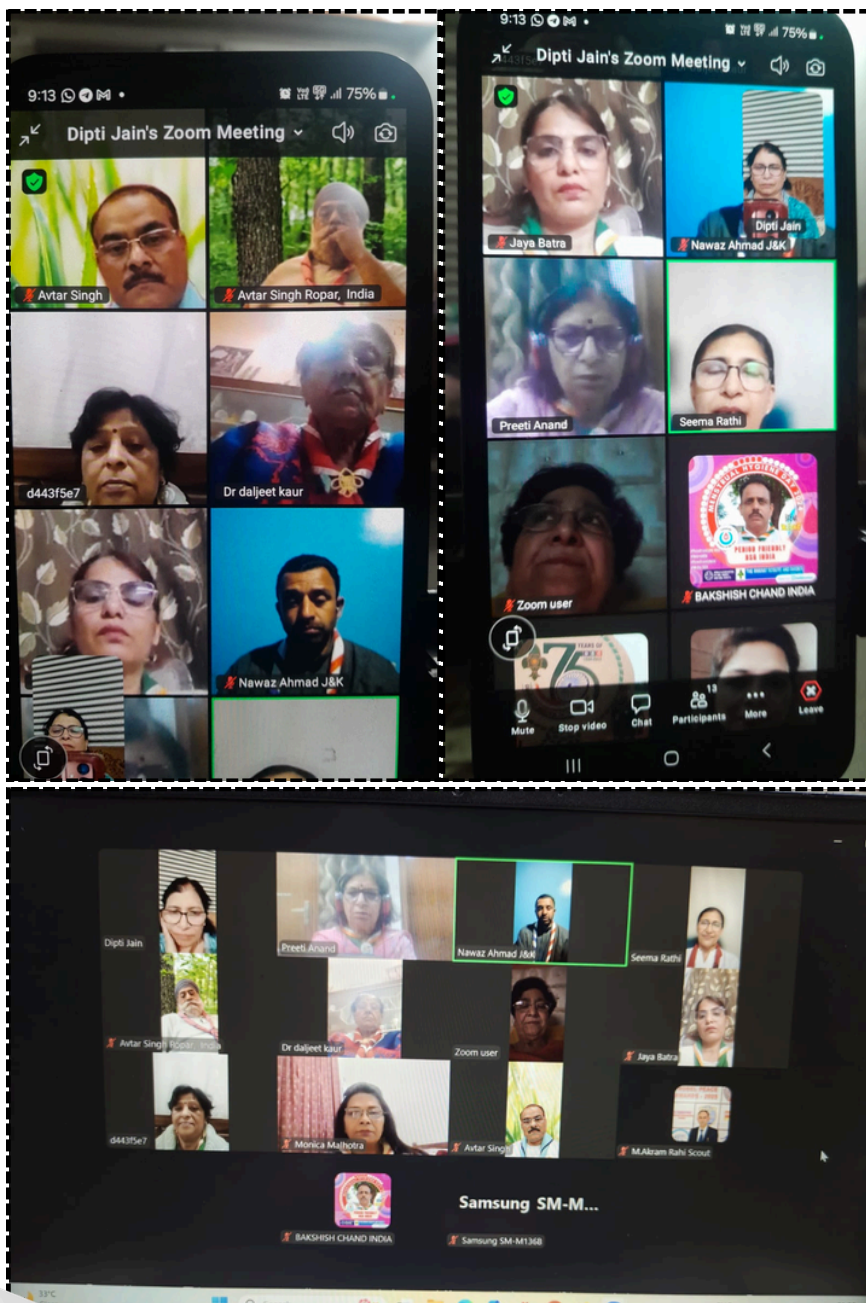
The meeting was very successful and the State Government has agreed to extend its support for the successful conduct of the event.

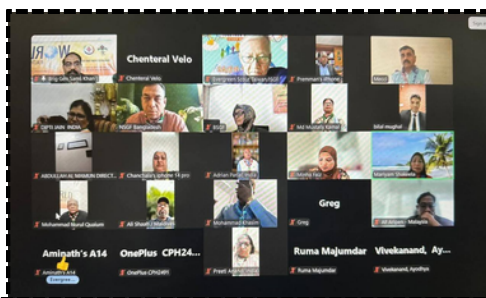

Chairman Ball Peng delivered his remarks and said Fellowship brings in spirit of service and brotherhood - he also added Evergreen Scouts background.

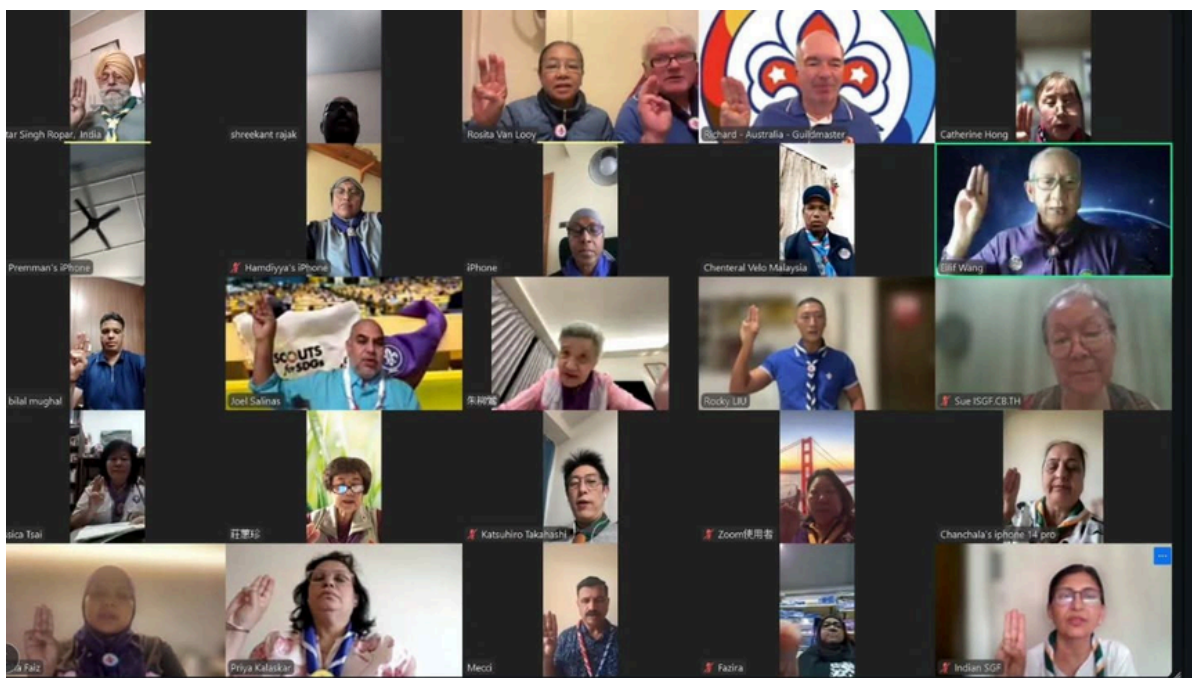

Overall 51 members joined from across the region and beyond.

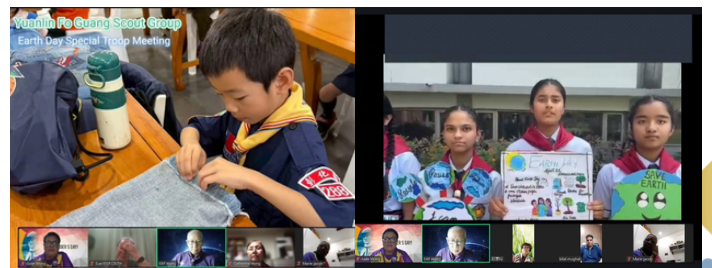
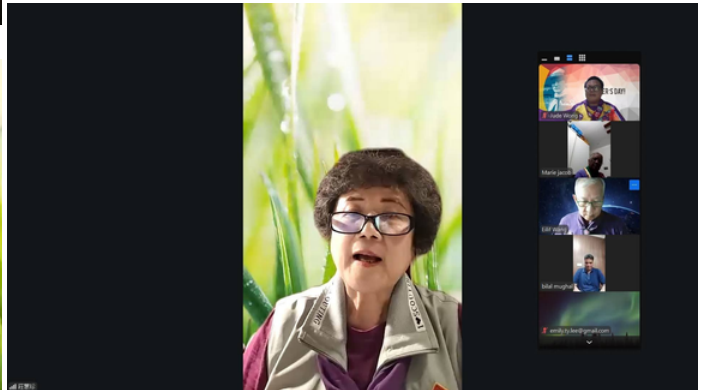

SDG Goal 3 : Good Health and Well-being:

Haryana State SGF:- Kaithal District: दिनांक 07 अप्रैल 2026 को हरियाणा राज्य भारत स्काउट्स एंड गाइड्स भीष्म एवं झांसी ओपन ग्रुप कैथल तथा इंडियन स्काउट एंड गाइड फैलोशिप जिला कैथल द्वारा विश्व स्वास्थ्य दिवस पर केशव बस्ती पंतनगर के शिक्षा केंद्र में स्वास्थ्य जांच शिविर का आयोजन किया गया। इस अवसर पर ग्रुप लीडर बख्शीश चंद ने बताया कि विश्व स्वास्थ्य दिवस पर ग्रुप द्वारा शिक्षा केंद्र के बच्चों के हीमोग्लोबिन HB व कैल्शियम की निःशुल्क जांच करवाई गई। ग्रुप द्वारा स्वस्थ बालिका स्वस्थ भारत अभियान के अंतर्गत समय-समय पर विभिन्न बस्तियों में बच्चों के लिए निःशुल्क जांच शिविर आयोजित किया जाते हैं। इस शिविर में 40 बच्चों के हीमोग्लोबिन व कैल्शियम की जांच की गई। डाक्टर के अनुसार हीमोग्लोबिन की नार्मल रेंज स्वस्थ पुरुष के शरीर में 13.5-17.5 व महिला के शरीर में 12.0-15.5 व बच्चे में 11.00-16.0 ग्राम (उम्र के अनुसार बदलता है) प्रति डेसीमल लीटर होनी चाहिए। हीमोग्लोबिन की कमी मुख्य रूप से आयरन, विटामिन B12, या रक्त की हानि के कारण होती है। इसे बढ़ाने के लिए आयरन-युक्त आहार पालक, अनार, चुकंदर, गुड़ और विटामिन C नींबू, आंवला का सेवन करें। कैल्शियम की कमी के कारण शरीर की हड्डियां कमजोर होना, मांसपेशियों में ऐंठन, जोड़ों में दर्द, दांतों में कैविटी व शरीर में थकान होती है। इसको दूर करने के लिए आहार में दूध, दही, पनीर, पालक, रागी, बाजरा, आदि शामिल करने होंगे। विटामिन डी बहुत जरूरी है जो हमें धूप से मिलता है। कैल्शियम की कमी को दूर करने के लिए संतुलित आहार, धूप, जीवन शैली में बदलाव जरूरी है। इस कार्यक्रम में रोवर पवन, आशु, जतिन, शिवम, अरमान, शिक्षा केंद्र की अध्यापिका अंजू, मोनिका व अतुल्य लैब से लोकेश हंस का सराहनीय योगदान रहा।

दिनांक 28 अप्रैल 2026 को हरियाणा राज्य भारत स्काउट्स एंड गाइड्स भीष्म एवं झांसी ओपन ग्रुप कैथल तथा इंडियन स्काउट एंड गाइड फैलोशिप जिला कैथल द्वारा कर्ण विहार बस्ती स्थित श्री नर नारायण सेवा समिति के निःशुल्क सिलाई केंद्र में मासिक धर्म स्वच्छता जागरूकता कार्यक्रम का आयोजन किया गया। ग्रुप लीडर बख्शीश गिरधर ने बताया कि यह कार्यक्रम *सतत विकास लक्ष्य संख्या 3 - उत्तम स्वास्थ्य और खुशहाली तथा स्वस्थ बालिका, स्वस्थ भारत अभियान के 73वें माह के अंतर्गत आयोजित किया गया। कार्यक्रम का मुख्य उद्देश्य किशोरियों और महिलाओं को मासिक धर्म के दौरान स्वास्थ्य, स्वच्छता और सुरक्षित आदतों के महत्व के प्रति जागरूक करना रहा। कार्यक्रम के शुभारंभ में इंडियन स्काउट एंड गाइड फैलोशिप से विजेता बुरा ने कहा कि मासिक धर्म के समय लड़कियों तथा महिलाओं को शारीरिक स्वच्छता का विशेष ध्यान रखना आवश्यक है। स्वच्छता की कमी से संक्रमण और अन्य स्वास्थ्य समस्याओं का खतरा बढ़ जाता है। इसलिए सही जानकारी, सुरक्षित स्वच्छता सामग्री और नियमित साफ-सफाई अपनाना अत्यंत जरूरी है। मासिक धर्म शरीर की एक स्वाभाविक जैविक प्रक्रिया है। इसके प्रति जागरूकता और सकारात्मक दृष्टिकोण जरूरी है। इस दौरान साफ सैनिटरी पैड का उपयोग, नियमित हाथ धोना और स्वच्छ वस्त्र पहनना संक्रमण से बचाव में सहायक है। स्वस्थ बालिका स्वस्थ भारत अभियान की संयोजिका पूजा गिरधर ने कहा कि स्वस्थ बालिका स्वस्थ भारत अभियान का यह 73 वां मासिक कार्यक्रम है। इस कार्यक्रम के अंतर्गत शहर की विभिन्न बस्तियों की जरूरतमंद लड़कियों को आगामी तीन माह के लिए निःशुल्क सैनेटरी नेपकिन वितरित करने के साथ विभिन्न सामाजिक विषयों पर भी जागरूक करते हैं। स्वास्थ्य और स्वच्छता के प्रति जागरूकता ही सशक्त समाज की नींव है। ग्रुप भविष्य में भी बालिकाओं के स्वास्थ्य एवं शिक्षा से जुड़े जागरूकता कार्यक्रम लगातार आयोजित करता रहेगा, ताकि वे स्वस्थ, शिक्षित और आत्मनिर्भर बन सकें। इस कार्यक्रम में रोवर सुभाष चंद, अमन, अभिनव, अनमोल, शिवम, जतिन, सिलाई केंद्र की अध्यापिका रेखा देवी का सराहनीय योगदान रहा।
